Birck Distinguished Professor. Before serving at Purdue, he was Professor in the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering and the Coordinated Science Laboratory, University of Illinois. He received the B.S.E. degree from Duke University, M. Div. degree from Trinity Evangelical Divinity School, and the Ph.D. in Electrical Engineering from the University of Illinois.

His research interests include dependable computing, testing, and failure diagnosis of integrated circuits. He is a Fellow of the IEEE and a Fellow of the ACM.
