

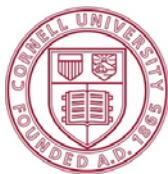


## ***W. Kent Fuchs***

*Provost*

Kent Fuchs is the Provost for Cornell University. As Provost he serves as the university's chief academic officer and chief operations officer. Prior to his appointment as Provost he was the Joseph Silbert Dean of the College of Engineering, Cornell University, and Professor in the School of Electrical and Computer Engineering. He was formerly Head of the School of Electrical and Computer Engineering, Purdue University, and Michael J. and Catherine R. Birck Distinguished Professor. Before serving at Purdue, he was Professor in the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering and the Coordinated Science Laboratory, University of Illinois. He received the B.S.E. degree from Duke University, M. Div. degree from Trinity Evangelical Divinity School, and the Ph.D. in Electrical Engineering from the University of Illinois.

His research interests include dependable computing, testing, and failure diagnosis of integrated circuits. He is a member of Tau Beta Pi (Engineering Honorary Society) and Eta Kappa Nu (Electrical Engineering Honorary Society). He is also a Fellow of the IEEE and a Fellow of the ACM.
